CONCLUSION: The access duration from Manila to a resort in Mangal Estate is NOT materially different from the access duration from Manila to a resort in Boracay. In fact, due to the additional legs/components/requirements of traveling to Boracay (as explained above), a seasoned traveler can reasonably surmise that there are more potential causes for delay in traveling to Boracay vs Mangal Estate.

NOTEWORTHY is Wasig Airfield, which currently accommodates chartered flights and is only a 15 minute drive to Mangal Estate. Although a long-term prospect, Wasig Airfield will eventually be upgraded to an airport with standards comparable to Caticlan Airport (Boracay), thereby reducing the access duration from Manila to Mangal Estate to 75 minutes (using an ATR-72 Turboprop) and a mere 60 minutes (using an Airbus A320).
